Survey Background

This year the Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Newfoundland and Labrador (PEGNL), the Association of Professional Geoscientists of Nova Scotia (APGNS), and the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of New Brunswick (APEGNB) agreed to jointly complete a salary survey. Many members, employers, and those considering a career in geoscience have expressed an interest in obtaining current statistics on geoscience salaries in the Atlantic region. It has been three years since members were asked to participate in the last survey.


The 2021 salary survey was conducted and compiled by ClearPicture Corp. The survey ran from the 20th of June until the 24th of September. This year 550 members were asked to participate in the survey, with 183 responding for a 33% participation rate. By association, responses rates were 31% for APEGNB, 40% for APGNS, and 26% for PEGNL. The margin of error (MOE) for the survey overall was 6.8%. By association, the MOE was 16.5% for APEGNB, 10.4% for APGNS, and 10.4% for PEGNL.


Only the aggregated data has been presented in this report. Individual members data will be kept confidential, and ClearPicture Corp. will not share that data with anyone. Data for groups under 4 has been suppressed within the report, but is still included in the aggregate data.

The mean, median, lower, and upper quartiles were calculated using the midpoint of each of the salary ranges. Where the mean is the average, median is the 50th percentile, lower quartile is the 25th percentile and the upper quartile is the 75th percentile.



Salary by Membership Status







Salary by Year of Graduation





Salary by Year of Graduation and Identity








Salary by Post-Graduate Studies







Salary by Post-Graduate Degree




<u>Geoscientists-in-Training – Salary by Years of Experience</u>

Salary by Job Position






