#### Survey Background

This year the Engineers Nova Scotia, the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of New Brunswick (APEGNB), Engineers PEI, and the Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Newfoundland and Labrador (PEGNL) agreed to jointly complete an engineering salary and benefits survey. Many members, employers, and those considering a career in engineering have expressed an interest in obtaining current statistics on engineering salaries in the Atlantic region. It has been three years since members were asked to participate in the last survey.

The 2024 salary and benefits survey was conducted and compiled by Truverus. The survey ran from July 2<sup>nd</sup> to July 26<sup>th.</sup> This year 12,617 members were asked to participate in the survey, with 3,780 responding for an overall participation rate of 30.0%. By association, response rates were 45.6% for Engineers PEI, 31.4% for Engineers NS, 29.5% for APEGNB, and 23.2% for PEGNL. The margin of error (MOE) for the survey overall was 0.8%. By association, the MOE was 1.2% for Engineers NS, 1.5% for APEGNB, 1.6% for PEGNL, and 3.8% for Engineers PEI.

Only the aggregated data has been presented in this report. Individual members data will be kept confidential, and Truverus will not share that data with anyone. Data for groups under 5 has been suppressed within the report but is still included in the aggregate data.

The mean, median, lower, and upper quartiles were calculated using the midpoint of each of the salary ranges. Where the mean is the average, median is the 50th percentile, lower quartile is the 25th percentile and the upper quartile is the 75th percentile.


#### 1 - Engineer-in-Training

#### Mean Median







# Mean Salary by Post-Graduate Degree







#### 8 - Salary by Discipline Mean Salary








# Mean Salary by Years of Experience as an Engineer-in-Training








